The old Control/ Turn around point is the Eagles Inn / Tafarn yr Eagles at the far end of Llanuwchllyn this now opens fully at 12 noon. You are recommended use this Bala Lake Railway cafe instead If you fancy a pint or if in a rush the garage at the T junction just beyond

Continue through Bala to R onto B4401 sp
Llanderfel 42k

L at cross (before bridge) sp **Llandderfel**

In village, 1st R on NCR16 47k **INFO opposite junction** What No is Bron Berwyn
Along narrow lanes to bear L at fork (ie SO)

R@T to cross river to uphill to **Cynwyd** 56k

L@T sp Corwen 56k

R@T (Care) on A5 sp **Corwen** 59k
